Lorenzo: I could not work in an office all day as it would drive me mad! Possibly I would have been a mechanic.



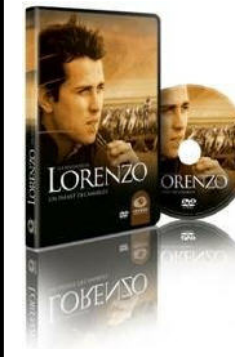
Monthly News: September
